

Maintenance

Skills and experience required:

- Enthusiastic and pro-active
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team
- Good DIY skills
- Full driving licence and access to a vehicle is desirable but not necessary

How this helps the SPCA:

The SPCA operates from a large site which requires lots of regular maintenance from grass cutting to minor repairs. In addition to help us raise much needed funds, and promote our work to the local community, we organise regular fundraising events onsite and our maintenance volunteers help prepare for the events.

What does this role involve?

- Grass cutting and other landscaping maintenance
- Minor DIY tasks around site
- Fixing event equipment, such as tables or game equipment
- Sweeping and tidying the outbuildings and other public areas

Time commitment required:

Very flexible. All we ask is that once you confirm your availability, you honour that commitment to enable us to ensure tasks are carried out. We can be flexible and accommodate shift workers who may have differing days off each week.

Some events may be held off site and help may be requested then.

How will we support you:

Your contact will be the SPCA committee, who will provide you with full information, guidance and direction. Tools and equipment will be provided. You will also be introduced to other volunteers, who you may be working with to.

What you can gain from volunteering with the SPCA:

- Meeting and working with new people
- Develop existing skills or gain new skills
- The experience of using your skills and abilities to help the SPCA, supporting the animals in our care.
